We seek to meet the unique needs of our community and we regularly check-in with our members to see how we can best accomplish this.

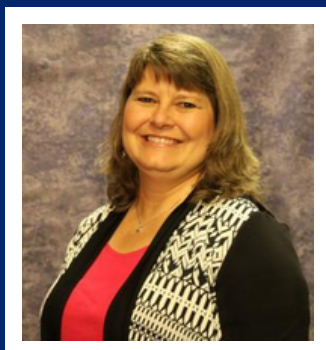

Dr. Debora J. Bell is a Professor and the Chair of the Department of Psychological Sciences at the University of Missouri. Her career has been devoted to advancing evidence-based, culturally-responsive, interpersonally compassionate, and personally balanced approaches to strengthening psychological science, developing the next generation of professionals, and improving lives in our communities. Her research focuses on graduate training and education in health service psychology, the delivery of accessible and evidence-based psychological services, and youth emotional adjustment. Dr. Bell's leadership and contributions to graduate training in health service psychology include serving as Editor for the journal *Training and Education in Professional Psychology*, Chair of the Council of Chairs of Training Councils, Chair of the Council of University Directors of Clinical Psychology, and Chair for the APA Commission on Accreditation. She currently serves as a Board Member for the Council of Graduate Departments of Psychology. She has also contributed to several academic training symposia and committees for the Association for Behavioral and Cognitive Therapies. In addition to co-authoring nearly 70 peer-reviewed articles and chapters, Dr. Bell is co-author of *Dissertations and Theses From Start to Finish: Psychology and Related Fields*, a guide for student writers.
